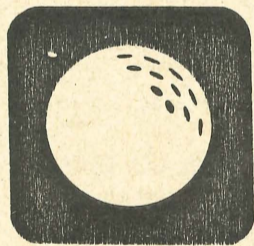
Competition is expected to be fierce, and the aim is to have fun - but the educational value of this training should not be overlooked by those who hope to play in "kitted up" games in the future.

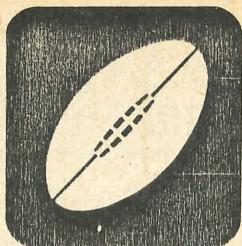
U.A.U. GOLF
